We have been very busy preparing our wheelhouse exhibit for the State Fair. We have received donations from many partners in this effort, and thank yous will appear on our keepitcleanmn.org and URLAA website and Facebook pages and on a poster at our exhibit.

To get the message out we will be holding a press conference at our exhibit on Friday, August 25 at 11 a.m. including a live Facebook feed. Multiple media organizations and special guests will be in attendance.
